Germs

Many of our residents have very sensitive immune systems and an illness that might be a slight inconvenience to you could be extremely serious for them.

By the way, have you had you flu vaccine? It is NOT too late to get your flu vaccine.

The CDC (Center for Disease Control) recommends you get the vaccination in the early fall, before flu season. However, getting vaccinated later can still be beneficial, even into January or later.

Bonfire Pet Registration Forms—reminder

Per current Bonfire Rules and Regulations (dated March 20, 2019) paragraph 6A:

"According to Florida law, all animals are required to be registered and immunized per recommended schedule. All pet owners must submit proof of immunizations and registrations to the office." This applies to owners, renters, and guests.

All pet owners have been requested to complete a form for each pet and turn it into the office with required documentation from the veterinarian by December 31, 2019. This form can be found on the Bonfire webpage (Residents Only section, under Forms), in the office, or in the Clubhouse. If you have not done so, please do so now. The Health & Safety Committee will be conducting a review of the forms in January and reporting this information to the Board of Directors.

NOTE: Lake County Florida no longer requires pets to be registered. Therefore, that section of the form can be ignored. HOWEVER, for everyone's health and safety, proof of current vaccinations is required. Thank you for your immediate attention to this matter.
