WHO YA GONNA CALL?

If you have an urgent need for services, but it's not a 911-level emergency, do you wonder who to call? There are many local agencies dedicated to providing free or low-cost services to the senior citizens in the area.

Here is a quick reference for some of the local services available to you. Phone numbers are given here; most of these agencies also have websites. More information can be found in a booklet pinned to the Health Committee bulletin board in the clubhouse.

✓ Depressed, sad, confused, scared, or just can't shake the blahs? Go to this website https://psychcentral.com/lib/depression-hotline-numbers/ for several options and more information to help you. Don't have internet access…here is one good number: 877-870-4673. It belongs to a group called The Samaritans, a non-profit organization, offer emotional

support to anyone who calls feeling lonely, depressed, suicidal, or just are looking for someone to talk to. Whatever the reason, you will get a trained volunteer who offers non-judgmental support.

- ✓ Are you or someone you know, being abused? By anyone…even your own family. Call the Abuse Hotline 800-962-2873
- ✓ Need a ride to the doctor, lab, or any medical facility? Call Lake County Connection 352-326-2278 or Medi-Cab 352-575-1240.
- ✓ Have trouble controlling alcohol usage? Call Alcoholics Anonymous 352-360-0960
- ✓ Need legal advice (free for persons age 60+)? Call Florida Senior Legal Helpline 888-895-7873
- ✓ Need glasses or hearing aids; insurance doesn't cover? Call Lion's Club 352-343-0180
- ✓ Need assistance with food or necessities, when the money just doesn't quite stretch far enough? Several agencies offer help. The agencies and their phone numbers are on pages 14-17 in the booklet.
- ✓ Lake County Sheriff's Office offers a Senior Watch Program. If you sign up, they will set up for you to call them daily to check in. If they do not hear from you, they will call a contact person you designate and ensure you are OK. To enroll, call 352-343-2101
