If you need immediate assistance, you may contact any Bonfire Board Member.

Notes from the Board:

- Our new Water Tank is due to be replaced in May. It is \$60,000, of which we have \$42,000 set aside. The remainder will come from our Contingency Fund. Water to the park will be turned off for 8 hours during this project.
- Fountains in our 2 ponds will operate from 10am-10pm daily. Lights will be turned on from 6pm-10pm.
- Fruit Trees and Palm Trees are not included in our Tree Trimming program, and should be kept trimmed by the homeowner.
- Any fruit that falls from a tree should be picked up and disposed of by the homeowner. Failure to keep up your yard will be addressed by our nuisance and upkeep policy.
- No open flame ground fires are permitted on Bonfire property. Only above ground commercially built and approved items may be used, ie. Gas & Charcoal Grills, or above ground fire bins with lids.
