Policy Number: BF012 - UPDATED

Policy Name: COVID-19 GUEST RESTRICTIONS

Effective Date: 05.06.2020

To be consistent with the recommendations by the CDC and the Governor of Florida, shareholders and residents only are permitted to use facilities that are open. All visitors, guests and/or caregivers must sign in immediately upon arrival and must be quarantined at shareholders or resident's home for 14 days before they are permitted to use any Bonfire facilities including the pool, sun pad, etc. Bonfire's Health and Safety Committee has reviewed this update.

HURRICANE SEASON: WHAT TO KNOW & WHAT TO DO



Hurricane season is here. By now, you may have heard plenty from the news media about what to do. So here it is, in a nutshell.

BE PREPARED

- Make an Emergency Plan. This website will help: <https://www.ready.gov/plan>.
- Know where you will go and how to get there if you have to evacuate.
- Gather Evacuation Supplies. Have enough supplies including medication, disinfectants, face coverings & pet supplies in your car trunk or go bag. Don't forget to make sure your insurance policies and personal documents, like IDs & deeds, wills, etc, are up to date and in a secure place. Make copies and keep them in a secure password protected digital space.
- Keep your cellphone(s) charged. Make sure your car has a full gas tank.

GET READY

- Declutter the drains and gutters of your home.
- Bring in outside furniture and other items. Anything can become a flying cannonball in hurricane winds.

STAY INFORMED

- Listen for emergency information and alerts. If told to evacuate by local officials, do so immediately.

COVID19

The Coronavirus Pandemic has created new concerns, especially if you have to go to a public shelter.

- Be prepared to take cleaning items with you, such as soap, hand sanitizer, disinfecting wipes.
- Maintain at least 6 feet between you and persons not of your immediate family.
- Wear face coverings while at the shelter.

RETURNING HOME

- Do not attempt to return home until local officials say it is safe.
- Beware of down electric lines or other safety situations.
- Have a ready means of communication to let family and/or friends know of your location.
