## NUISANCE WILD ANIMALS

Recently, there have been sightings of wild animals in the park. Small animals... cute little armadillos, possums, raccoons, and squirrels. Many think they are adorable and harmless. Think again. These rascals can do serious damage if they get under your home. They love to gnaw at insulation and wiring. They dig tunnels to where they want to get.

So, what to do? Watch for signs of their presence. Holes dug in your yard, especially near your home, would be a surefire sign. If you are not in the park, ask the person you have hired to maintain your property to look for signs as they are mowing and trimming. Then, if such signs are seen, or if you catch the animals on your security cameras, it would be wise to act before damage is done.

It is the responsibility of the homeowner to maintain their home and property in Bonfire. Therefore, the correct action is to contact a local pest control company (not the board). If you Google, "wild animal nuisance control", several local companies can be found.

Above all, remember, DO NOT feed ANY wildlife.

We are pleased to provide you with this year's Annual Water Quality Report. This report is designed to inform you about the quality of water and services we have delivered to you over the past year. Our constant goal is to provide you with a safe and dependable supply of drinking water. We want you to understand the efforts we make to continually improve the water treatment process and protect our water resources. We are committed to ensuring the quality of your water. Our water is produced by (2) groundwater wells that draw water from the Floridan Aquifer and is disinfected by chlorination. If you have any questions concerning your water utility, please contact General Utilities at (352-787-2493) between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. We want our valued customers to be informed about their water utility. Bonfire Mobile Home Park routinely monitors for contaminants in your drinking water according to Federal and State laws. The state allows us to monitor for some contaminants less than once per year because the concentration for these contaminants do not change frequently. Except when indicated otherwise, this report is based on the results for the period January 1 to December 31, 2023. All water analyses are the most recent sampling in accordance with the Safe Drinking Water Act.

In this table, you will find many terms and abbreviations you might not be familiar with. To help you better understand these terms, we've provided the following definitions:

- Parts per million (ppm) or Milligrams per liter (mg/L):** One part by weight of analyte to 1 million parts by weight of the water sample.
- Parts per billion (ppb) or Micrograms per liter (ug/l):** One part by weight of analyte to 1 billion parts by weight of the water sample.
- Becquerel per liter (pCi/L):** A measure of the radioactivity in water.
- Action Level (AL):** The concentration of a contaminant that, if exceeded, triggers treatment or other requirements that a water system must follow.
- NA:** Not applicable.
- Maximum Contaminant Level (MCL):** The highest level of a contaminant that is allowed in drinking water. MCL's are set as close to the MCLG's as feasible using the best available treatment technology.
- Maximum Contaminant Level Goal (MCLG):** The level of a contaminant in drinking water below which there is no known or expected risk to health. MCLG's allow for a margin of safety.
- Maximum Residual Disinfectant Level or MRDL:** The highest level of a disinfectant allowed in drinking water. There is convincing evidence that addition of a disinfectant is necessary for control of microbial contaminants.
- Maximum Residual Disinfectant Level Goal or MRDLG:** The level of a drinking water disinfectant below which there is no known or expected risk to health. MRDLGs do not reflect the benefits of the use of disinfectants to control microbial contaminants.
- DEP:** Florida Department of Environmental Protection
- EPA:** United States Environmental Protection Agency.
