Did You Know.....History of Bonfire Mobile Home Village

The property was originally owned by Milton and Jewel Hooks, who sold it in 1959 to Henry Morrison and widower Sarah Morrison. It was then called Haines Creek Cottages and Fishing Resort.

In 1961, Sarah Morrison (then Sarah Horne) and her husband, Claude Horne, sold the property (which was comprised of 6-7 fishing cottages) to Talmadge and Blanche Etheredge. They renamed the property Bonfire Mobile Home Village, after a place in the Miami area that Talmadge liked.

By 1973, while the only paved road was county road Lock Rd, the streets gained their current names. Many are the names of the Etheredge's granddaughters.

In 1981, the property was sold to Dr. Ronald and Charlotte Cunning. It was changed from a family park to an adults only park. In addition, Bonfire joined the Federation of Mobile Home Owners of Florida, Inc.

Bonfire became incorporated in 1984 and was called Bonfire Cooperative Association, Inc. In 1993, the Cooperative Association bought the property from the Cunnings. Residents bought shares, thus becoming shareholders.

This information was taken from the History of Bonfire Mobile Home Village, published in 2009, compiled by Dotti Champion.

Shareholders Meeting: (The following was submitted by Fran Oldfield)

February 19, 2022

Considerations, as a Bonfire Shareholder to Think About Prior To March 2, 2022 Special Shareholders Meeting at 10 AM

**I would like to share MY personal thoughts with you on the upcoming Special Meeting to vote to replace the old original (Fish Camp Days) Plot plan map with the new updated Bonfire map, as I have been involved with it since the start. Fran Oldfield 859-760-1384

Our current Board of Directors, nor its President, did not instigate updating the Lake County, old original fish camp map, currently attached to our Co-Operative Proprietary Lease. Lake County Did!

Then Lake County said, "Bonfire, you must update the plot plan map. Not your map in the directory, but Lake County's old original map." Bonfire volunteers started the project, May 2020.

Once the updated template was completed Bonfire had to hire a Civil engineering Company, Wickes Engineering, to create a new updated plot plan map. We as Shareholders, have paid to have this map updated.

Then Lake County had to approve the updated plot plan map. Approval from Lake County was received November 15, 2021.

Now the **State of Florida** says that we, Bonfire Shareholders, are required to vote to change our Co-Op documents to replace the original fish camp map, with the newly created, updated map.

The Florida Statue states that two thirds (2/3's) of the Bonfire shareholders must vote YES to be able to change our documents. That equates to 157 + 1 = 158 shareholders must vote YES to approve the change.

Note: if this **is not approved** by the above votes, we will not be able to sell the other three (3) lots. (408 Kristi, 631A Misti, and 608 Tammi Court.) Non passage will eliminate the possibility of selling the lots which would add \$58,500 to our operating funds. Neither would we get the \$1440 per year in maintenance fees, from each of the three (3) lots.

It does not take long to determine whose pockets the funds will come out of to continue to fund the future operating costs of the park. THE SHAREHOLDERS' POCKETS! WE ARE THE ONES WHO OWN THIS CO-OP.

Why would you not want to support **your investment** in Bonfire and have the Co-Operative documents be accurate and reflect how the park is today?? The Board of Directors cannot approve this. They are only the administrators of the meeting.

Here are the ways you can vote: Attend the Special Meeting or submit a Proxy and give it to someone who will be attending the meeting or fill out your proxy and put in the black mail box at the office door.

Please take any personal feelings you have toward any board members out of your vote. They are Shareholders and are volunteers elected to run our park.

The purpose of the Bonfire Health & Safety Committee is to provide education and information to ensure the health and safety of all the residents of our community. How Does Sleep Affect Your Heart Health?

Sleep is not a luxury. It is critical to good health. Sleep helps your body repair itself. Getting enough good sleep also helps you function normally during the day.

Adults who sleep less than 7 hours each night are more likely to say they have had health problems, including heart attack, asthma and depression. Some of these health problems raise the risk for heart disease, heart attack and stroke. These health problems include high blood pressure, Type 2 diabetes and obesity.

What can you do to get better sleep?

- Stick to a regular sleep schedule.
- Get enough natural light; try going for a morning or lunchtime walk.
- Get enough physical activity during the day, but not within a few hours of bedtime.
- Avoid artificial light within a few hours of bedtime, especially from your computer or phone.
- Don't eat or drink within a few hours of bedtime; especially avoid alcohol and foods high in fat or sugar.
- Keep your bedroom cool, dark and quiet.
- Work with your health care team to identify obstacles to good sleep, including other medical conditions.
