STROKE AWARENESS

May is American Stroke Awareness Month per the National Stroke Association, a division of the American Heart Association.

By learning the F.A.S.T. warning signs, you might just save a life from stroke.

Face drooping. Does one side of the face droop or is it numb? Ask the person to smile. Is the person's smile uneven?

Arm weakness. Is one arm weak or numb? Ask the person to raise both arms. Does one arm drift downward?

Speech. Is speech slurred? Is the person unable to speak or hard to understand? Ask the person to repeat a simple sentence like "The Sky is blue."

Time to call 9-1-1. If someone shows any of these symptoms, even if the symptoms go away, call 9-1-1 and get to a hospital immediately. Check the time so you will know when the first symptoms appeared.
