The office is not open for walk-ins. Anyone can call with questions or make an appointment to meet with office staff. If you need immediate assistance, you may contact any Bonfire Board Member.

Notes from the Board:

- Effective January 1, 2023, the maintenance fee will be \$135.00 per month. If your bank automatically sends in your monthly payment, please contact your bank and notify them of the increase. If you have submitted personal checks in advance to the office, you will need to submit a check for \$15.00 each month for the balance due.
- Please don't feed stray cats in our community as they will reproduce and cause hardships for your neighbors.
- Dept. of Forestry does not allow any open pit or ground burning within 150 ft. of a dwelling. This law covers all of our community, and will be enforced. An out-of-control fire could cause irreparable damage.
- Our 5 year Water Tank inspection did not pass. The County is giving us 1 year to replace. We have a Reserve Account to help fund this project. We have currently lowered the water pressure in the park to keep the tank operating for now.

Home Security ____

Recently, there have been reports of break-ins and thefts in our park. This is not new, it has been happening for a long time. Bonfire is not a gated community with security guards. So, what can you do to protect your home and your belongings?

- Always lock your doors and windows, even if you intend to be away only a short time.
- When you go out, leave a few lights on and even a television or other noise to make it appear that someone is home.
- Have a special lock installed, or place a cut-off broom/mop handle in the track of sliding glass doors to prevent the door from being opened.
- Install deadbolt locks on all exterior doors.
- Maintain your lawn or have it maintained when away on vacation.
- Store barbecue grills, lawn mowers, four wheelers, bicycles and other valuable items out of sight.
- Even when you are home, make sure sheds and storage buildings are locked and windows covered.
- Make certain all door hinges on exterior doors are on the inside.
- Keep shrubs and trees trimmed, particularly those located close to your home.
- Make sure your home is well-lit on the outside.
- Install security cameras.
- Avoid leaving a spare key under a flower pot, doormat or other area.

Bonfire Village is not in a "bad" area, but all homes are susceptible to crime. Take steps to protect what is yours. Do not *expect* others to do this for you. Keep your eyes open for your neighbors. Remember: *If you SEE something, SAY something!* Call 911 to report what you see, *then* advise someone on the Board of Directors. We have a great community, but it takes everyone doing their part to keep it that way.
